Commingled Recycling

These materials go in your tan cart:

Paper/Cardboard

Junk mail, flyers, office paper, envelopes, gift wrap & cards (no foil), post-it notes, paper bags, newspaper, cardboard (please cut to fit in cart) paperboard, phone books, shredded paper (loose in a paper bag or cereal box)



Metal

Please rinse. Tin & aluminum cans, aerosol cans, clean foil, pie pans, metal lids



Plastic

Please rinse and remove screw-top lids and pumps. Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs (yogurt, margarine), jars (peanut butter), nursery pots & buckets (smaller than 5 gallons)



NO Plastic bags, plastic screw-top lids, Styrofoam, glass or garbage in the tan recycling cart.

Mixed Organics

These materials go in the light gray cart:

Plants & Flowers
Yard Trimmings
Grass Clippings

ALL Food scraps including proteins and dairy

Pizza boxes and other food contaminated papers like paper towels and coffee filters.



NO Plastic bags, pet waste or garbage in the yard debris cart.

On the Side

These materials are collected separately beside the tan cart:

Glass

Place bottles and jars in the glass bin next to your tan cart. Glass is collected on your regular service day, one time per month. Call our office if you are unsure which week is your glass week.



Motor Oil

Place in a plastic container with a tight fitting screw on lid, beside the tan cart. (Oil containers must not be larger than 1 gallon in size)



NO Window glass, ceramic or Pyrex in glass bin.



About our Services:

Holiday Schedule:

We work on all week days except the following: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas. If your regular service day falls on one of these holidays, your carts will be collected one

day later. Service for the remainder of the week will also be one day later.

(Friday service will be collected on Saturday on these weeks)

About Your Carts

- Please place carts out to the street by 7:00 am. Be sure to place containers 4 feet apart and 10 feet from other items like vehicles, shrubs and mailboxes.
- When putting carts out for collection, remember that material should not be above the top of the cart and the lid should close for the automated arm to work correctly and to avoid additional charges. This includes garbage, recycling, and yard waste.
- Only put carts out when full or convenient. Truck emissions are lower when we eliminate unnecessary stops.
- A cart's footprint is approximately 26" x 26" and is made of 20% recycled plastic.

About Our Depots

Republic Services offers curbside services for most of the customers in our service area. We provide recycling depots for customers who do not have curbside collection.

Our recycling depot is located at:

110 NE Walnut Blvd in Corvallis (intersection of Hwy 99 and Walnut Blvd). This depot accepts an expanded list of materials.

Hours of Operation are:

7 am to 7 pm

Open 7 days a week

The depot is closed on New Years Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day.

Items accepted at the main depot:

- Commingled Recycling (as described on reverse)
- Glass
- Cardboard
- Motor Oil
- Cooking Oil (in original container with lid)
- Scrap Metal
- E-waste (computers, monitors, TV's, laptops)
- Plastic Film/Bags (must be stretchable)
- Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Cell phones
- Ink cartridges

The above materials are accepted at the main depot only, not at other depots or in curbside carts.

Depots are also available in Alpine, behind the Alsea Store and once a month in Wren for commingled recycling, cardboard and glass.

NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLE AT THE DEPOT:
Fluorescent light tubes or Styrofoam
