All about trash and recycling

Service Provider: Republic Services, 541 754-0444

Service provided by association:

- Trash: One 32-gallon container every other Tuesday. See <http://www.thta.org> for schedule.
- Recycle: One beige container of mixed recycling items every Tuesday.
- Yard debris and food waste: One container every Tuesday. Note: Two yard debris containers are located beside the tool shed by the pool and may be used by residents.
- Glass: Tuesday of the second full week in each month

Email info@thta.org. Please do not contact Republic Services concerning services provided by the Association. This must be done by the Timberhill Townhouse Association's designated representative.

Optional at resident's expense:

- Additional 32-gallon trash container with every other week pickup. Email info@thta.org for details.

Pickup: All containers must be placed on the outside of a designated route no earlier than the day prior to pickup. On the Walnut side, the designated route goes around the pool. On the 29th street side, the designated route is the loop from the 29th street entrance. Leave sufficient space between containers to facilitate mechanical pickup. Containers must be removed within 24 hours after pickup.

Storage: Trash, recycle and yard debris containers must be screened from view except when placed for pickup.

House number: All containers must be marked with the house number.

Recycle: Residents are encouraged to take full advantage of Republic's recycling services – mixed, food waste and glass. Learn more by downloading Republic's [recycling brochure](#).
