Trash—what can be done?

Every week THTA residents roll their trash and recycle containers out to the pool area for emptying. This is good. Every week the drive around the pool and adjacent paths is blocked by those containers. This is not good.

Here is the summary from the May 2026 minutes on this subject:

An issue about where garbage & recycling cans are placed on Tuesdays was reported to Mary Frances. Even though space is limited, **roadways must not be blocked by cans waiting for pick up**. In addition, **cans need to be placed at least 2 feet apart for accessibility**.

Suggestions to alleviate the problem:

- 1) Try to alternate pick-up days between garbage & recycling cans when possible. Garbage cans are picked up bimonthly, so the recycling could be put out on alternate Tuesdays. We recognize this this would not always be possible.
- 2) If you only have one bag, you might add it to a neighbor's can that is not full rather than putting your whole can out. Be sure that the garbage is tightly sealed in a bag before you borrow space.
